

ILLINOIS CHECKLIST FOR

SECOND INVOLUNTARY INPATIENT ADMISSION EXAMINATIONS:

Timing:

- As soon as possible but not later than 24 hours, excluding Saturdays, Sundays and holidays, after admission of a respondent. 405 ILCS 5/3-610
- If the examination results in an inpatient admission certificate, that second certificate shall be promptly filed with the local court. *Id.*

Examiner:

- Psychiatrist
 - **Unless** an inpatient certificate of examination has already been completed by a psychiatrist following the respondent's admission, then the following persons may conduct the timely second examination: another psychiatrist, clinical psychologist, advanced practice psychiatric nurse, or qualified examiner. 405 ILCS 5/3-610

Remote Video Examinations:

- May only be used for certification when a psychiatrist is not on-site within the required time (necessity, *not* convenience). 405 ILCS 5/3-610
- If the examination is performed in this way, that fact **shall** be noted on a resulting inpatient certificate (DHS Form provides a box that the examiner should select). *Id.*
- Requirements for a valid Remote Video Examination (89 Ill. Adm. Code 140.403(a)(5)):
 - Multimedia communications equipment that includes, at a minimum:
 - Audio and video equipment permitting two-way, real-time interactive communication between the patient and the distant site provider.
 - NOTE: Telephones, facsimile machines, and electronic mail systems **do not meet the definition of an interactive telecommunication system.**
