## **REMINDER: MARCH 2 IS THE DEADLINE TO REPORT THE 2019 OSHA 300A INFORMATION TO OSHA**

### **Is OSHA electronic reporting the same thing as the Survey of Occupational Injuries and Illnesses?**

No. OSHA's electronic reporting requirements do not change requirements for completing the Survey of Occupational Injuries and Illnesses. BLS recognizes that in some cases employers will be required to report information to both OSHA and BLS, and will continue efforts to make the submission process as convenient as possible.

- **The collection of CY 2019 data and beyond will include the collection of establishments' Employer Identification Numbers (EIN).** If you submit your data using a csv file or API, you can view the new layout by selecting the "How" tab above
