
MANDATORY COVID-19 VACCINATIONS

TEMPORARY OSHA RECORDKEEPING RULE

OSHA has encouraged employers to request that their employees receive the COVID-19 vaccination.

Therefore, so as not to discourage vaccination, OSHA **will not enforce** 29 CFR Part 1904's recording requirements to require **any employers to record worker side effects from COVID-19 vaccination** through May 2022. OSHA will reevaluate its position at that time to determine the best course of action moving forward. This includes those employers who require their employees to receive the vaccination as a condition of employment.
